3. Annual School-Based Health Screening in Primary Schools

The School Health Service will be visiting Hong Wen School from Tuesday, 21 July 2026 to Monday, 3 August 2026 to conduct the annual health screening exercise for all students.

- A message to all Parents from the Health Promotion Board (HPB) listing the different services for the different levels was sent out via Parents Gateway on Thursday, 21 May 2026
- Immunisation is scheduled for Primary 5 students only.
- If your child/ward is in Primary 5, please access the HPB's Child Consent Portal to submit the online consent before the start of the Health Screening exercise.
- Only Primary 5 students are to submit their Health Booklets to their Form Teachers by Friday, 17 July 2026.

Your child/ward will be informed of the screening schedule nearer the date.

4. Commemoration of Racial Harmony Day (RHD) – Tuesday, 21 July 2026

The school will commemorate RHD on **Tuesday, 21 July 2026**. This year's theme, "Our People, Our Tapestry", reminds us of the strength and beauty of our multicultural heritage. There will be an assembly programme and recess activities to help students appreciate racial harmony and multiculturalism. Students are encouraged to come to school in **Singapore's other ethnic group's traditional attire** (e.g. Baju Kurung, Baju Melayu, Kebaya, Kurta, Punjabi Suit, Lehenga, Sari etc). Students will still be required to wear school shoes and socks. (*Note: it is optional for students to don traditional costumes.*)

5. Monthly Focal Value for July – Compassion

The Monthly Focal Value Programme aims to build the character of our students by purposefully instilling in them our school core values. In July, we will be focusing on the value of "Compassion". We believe that fostering compassion is a vital aspect of our students' character development. Compassion enables our students to empathise with others, show kindness, and offer support to those in need. This valuable trait not only strengthens interpersonal relationships but also contributes to a caring and inclusive learning environment.

We seek your partnership in integrating this value into your child's daily life at home. The table below illustrates how your child can demonstrate compassion in his/her day-to-day interactions with his/her family members. Parents can also refer to page 14 of the school diary for the same table.

Discussing acts of kindness, encouraging empathy towards others, and highlighting instances where compassion made a difference can have a significant impact on others. By emphasizing compassion, parents play a crucial role in instilling these values in their children.

6. Phase 1 Registration for 2026 Exercise

The Phase 1 registration is for a Singapore Citizen (SC) or Permanent Resident (PR) child born between 2 January 2020 and 1 January 2021 (both dates inclusive) and has an older sibling currently studying in our primary school.

Parents who are registering their child under Phase 1 are to register online (on your own) during the Phase 1 registration period **from 9am on Tuesday, 30 June 2026 to 4.30pm on Thursday, 2 July 2026.**

If your child is a non-SC/non-PR, your child will not be eligible for registration at Phase 1 or Phase 2. The school has informed parents via Parents Gateway on 20 May 2026 that parents need to submit an online Indication of Interest from 20 May to 4.30pm on 25 May 2026 if your child is a non-SC/non-PR.

7. Joyous Endeavours With the English Language (JEWEL) @ HWS 2026

Throughout the week, numerous engaging and fun activities will be organised to achieve this objective. This year, we would like to invite our students to come to school dressed up as characters related to the theme of Little Detectives on 17 July. This is an optional activity. The students can be dressed up as characters in storybooks related to mystery and detective work. They will still need to wear their school shoes and will be allowed to be in their costume for the whole day.

There will also be sale of English storybooks on 15 & 16 July. Your child/ward may bring extra money to school to purchase the storybooks if he/she is interested. We look forward to your child's active participation in all the activities with your encouragement and support.

3. 常年校内健康检查

新加坡保健促进局的学校健康服务团队将于 7 月 21（星期二）日至 8 月 3 日（星期一）到本校为我校学生提供一年一次的健康体检。

有关新加坡保健促进局对于各年级提供的体检项目，学校已在 5 月 21 日通过“家长联通”（Parents Gateway）应用程序通知家长。

只有小学五年级的学生会有免疫接种。如果您的孩子就读五年级，请在您的孩子体检之前登入新加坡保健促进局的网上平台给予您的许可。

只有小学五年级的学生需要在 7 月 17 日（星期五）之前，把身体健康册子交给级任老师。您的孩子会在稍后收到有关检查的时间表。

4. 种族和谐日（7 月 21 日—星期二）

每年 7 月 21 日是种族和谐日，我校将于 7 月 21 日（星期二）纪念该节日。今年的主题是“多元共融 同心织锦”，反应我国各种族的独特性，但又能融洽地相处，一同打造一个和谐的社会。当天，我校将通过周会与休息节举办不同的活动，让学生更深入地了解种族和谐、多元文化和社会凝聚力的重要性。谨此鼓励学生于当天穿着新加坡其他种族群体的传统服饰到校（例如：马来传统服装 Baju Kurung、Baju Melayu、Kebaya，以及印度传统服装 Kurta、Punjabi Suit、Lehenga、Sari 等），以促进对多元文化的认识与欣赏。学生仍须穿着校鞋及袜子。（此项活动[穿着其他种族群体的传统服饰]属自愿参与性质。）

5. 七月份月度焦点价值观 - 关爱

7. 2026 年宏文学校英语语文活动周（JEWEL@HWS 2026）
