4. Joyous Endeavours With English Language (JEWEL) @ HWS 2024

With effect from this year, our Speak Good English Movement (SGEM) has been renamed Joyous Endeavours **W**ith English Language (JEWEL)@HWS. This change enables us to incorporate various enjoyable English-based activities beyond oral communication, enriching our programme. This year, JEWEL@HWS will take place from <u>Monday, 8 July 2024</u> to <u>Friday, 12 July 2024</u>. The objective of the programme remains to instil the love for the English Language in our students. Throughout the week, numerous engaging and fun activities will be organised to achieve this objective.

On 8 July, Monday, as part of our activities, your child is encouraged to come to school dressed as his/her favourite storybook character. Whether it is classic fairy tales, superheroes or fantasy creatures, we would like to encourage your child to bring these characters to life. In line with our school values, we kindly request that your child selects a character embodying positive traits when choosing his/her costume.

We look forward to your child's active participation in all the activities with your encouragement and support.

5. Commemoration of Racial Harmony Day (RHD) – Monday 15 July 2024

RHD is observed on 21 July every year. The school will commemorate RHD on Monday, 15 July 2024. The theme for RHD this year is "Singapore: Our Multicultural Mosaic", which not only reflects how communities in Singapore are unique but are also intertwined with others to depict the cultural diversity that characterises life in Singapore.

There will be an assembly programme on 15 July, followed by recess activities on 15 and 16 July to enable students to gain a deeper appreciation of racial harmony, multiculturalism and social cohesion. Students will wear their school uniforms on both days.

6. Arrival and Dismissal via Vehicular Transport

This is a reminder to all parents who drive their children to school to use the school main gate along Towner Road. Upon entering the school compound, please use the left lane only to let your child alight from the car, unless directed by our security guard or teachers on duty to use the right lane.

Please do not use May Road as the drop-off point for your child as many of our students who walk to the school use May Road to enter the school.

There should also be no car pick up at Gate 1 (near bridge to Whampoa) and along May Road.

You may park at the nearby HDB carpark and proceed to Gate 1 or 5 to pick your child.

We seek your cooperation to adhere to the above as the safety of our children is our priority.

7. Monthly Focal Value for July – Compassion

The Monthly Focal Value Programme aims to build the character of our students by purposefully instilling in them our school core values. In July, we will be focusing on the value of "Compassion". We believe that fostering compassion is a vital aspect of our students' character development. Compassion enables our students to empathize with others, show kindness, and offer support to those in need. This valuable trait not only strengthens interpersonal relationships but also contributes to a caring and inclusive learning environment.

(4) 讲标准英语运动(JEWEL)

今年我校将于7月8日(星期一)至7月12日(星期五)进行"讲标准英语运动"。这项活动的英文 名称将由 SGEM 改成 JEWEL,让我们融入了更多有趣的活动, 寓教于乐。举办以上活动是为了培养学 生热爱学习英语, 期待您支持与鼓励孩子积极参与。

(5)种族和谐日(7月15日—星期一)

每年7月21日是种族和谐日,我校将于7月15日(星期一)纪念该节日。今年的主题是"多元文化 马赛克",反应我国各种族的独特性,但又能融洽地相处,一同打造一个和谐的社会。当天,我校将 通过周会与休息节(15日及16日)举办不同的活动,让学生更深入地了解种族和谐、多元文化和社会 凝聚力的重要性。学生于这两日不必换上各种族的传统服装,穿校服即可。

(6) 开车接送孩子的相关事宜

温馨提醒所有开车送孩子上学的家长使用位于陶纳路 (Towner Road) 的学校正门。在驶入学校后,校 方只允许学生从左边的车道下车;若有特殊情况,请遵从校卫或执勤教师的指示。

由于大部分步行到学校的学生都使用梅路 (May Road)进入学校,恳请家长与校方合作,勿让您的孩子 在梅路下车。

此外,我们也不允许开车的家长在放学的时候在学校的一号门外(靠近通往黄埔的行人天桥处)以及 沿着梅路的路段让孩子上车。您可以将车停放在附近组屋区的停车场,并走到一号或五号门接孩子回 家。我们恳请各位家长合作,顾及所有学生的安全。

(7) 七月份月度焦点价值观 - 关爱
