(4) Chinese Language and Cultural Fortnight 2024

The Chinese Language and Cultural Fortnight has commenced this week and will continue until Friday, 5 April 2024. Through this event, we hope to immerse our students in an environment rich in Chinese language and culture to enable them to learn more about the language and become confident users of the Chinese language.

During the first week, students can look forward to the sale of Chinese storybooks on 26 & 27 March. Lower primary students will participate in Speech & Drama level presentations and engaging classroom activities to practice their Chinese language skills. For our upper primary students, we have organized a series of workshops including Comic Drawing, Dragon & Lion Dance, and Tea Appreciation, offering students insights to various aspects of Chinese culture.

In the second week, there will be a Language Games Carnival on 1 & 2 April and a Street Dance Performance during Assembly on 3 April. Pre-Assembly Sharing sessions will also take place throughout the two weeks.

Please encourage your child/ward to participate in these enriching activities actively. Thank you for your support in making this event meaningful for our students.
