Hong Wen School Examination Policies
CONDUCT OF PUPILS DURING/AFTER EXAMINATIONS

- Pupils should ensure that they do not possess any unauthorised electronic devices (eg. mobile phones) with them at all times during the examination.
- All unauthorised electronic devices should be switched off and placed in the school bags during the examinations.
- Pupils are to ensure that they do not have any unauthorised notes of any form with them during the examinations.
- Pupils should not communicate with their classmates during the duration of the examination. Any form of communication will be deemed as an attempt to cheat.
- Any unauthorized alteration of marks or answers on the examination scripts by pupils after examination, is considered a form of cheating.
- Pupils caught cheating or attempting to cheat will be deemed to have committed a disciplinary offence and will be awarded a zero for the paper.

The school adopts a zero tolerance policy in relation to cheating and non-adherence to the abovementioned conduct.
